Protected Customary Rights

2 NGATI MURIWAI HAPU ancestors utilised the common marine and coastal area for fishing, kaimoana gathering, transport, rongoa collecting, communicating hapu matauranga, bird snaring, firewood, stones, aquatic plants, fishing tuna;

The Applicant Group:

3. NGATI MURIWAI HAPU whakapapa to TOI KAIRAKAU WHO LIVED GENERATIONS AGO, TO MURIWAI, TURANGAPIKITOI, RANGIPARORO AND KAHUKI and link to the application area (Maraetotara Stream to Haurere Point) CHRISTINA DAVIS was appointed to make this application for and on behalf of NGATI MURIWAI HAPU in February 2017.

Area to which the application relates:

4. The area to which this application relates is the common marine and coastal area (as defined in s9 of the Act) that is bounded:

5.

- a. on the landward side by the line of mean high-water springs of Hikuwai Beach;
- b. on the seaward side by the outer limits of the territorial sea;
- c. thus then the mouth of the Maraetotara Stream (west point) east to Ohiwa Harbour, following the foreshore around the harbor to Ohiwa (north east point of the harbour) thence east to the mouth of the Waiotahi River, east to the mouth of the Waioeka River, thence to Haurere Point (east point) including the tidal aspects of rivers and streams, estuaries, and the islands in the Ohiwa Harbour: Ohakana Island, Uretara Island, Whangakopikpiko Island, Motuotu Islands, Hokiana Island and Pataua Island, to the outer limits of the territorial sea (eastward and westward).
- 6 The area includes the common marine and coastal area surrounding the following islands: Ohakana Island, Uretara Island, Whangakopikpiko Island, Motuotu Islands, Hokiana Island and Pataua Island.



Grounds on which the protected customary rights order is sought:

- 7. The grounds on which this order is sought are that:
 - a. NGATI MURIWAI HAPU being a coastal group has relied heavily on Fishing, Use of resources both commercially and domestically and played an instrumental role in environmental protection of every conceivable kind and exercised and practiced wahi taapu for tangihanga and urupa purposes; and
 - b. NGATI MURIWAI HAPU also undertakes the following activities in the common marine and coastal area: Exercising Mana Motuhake and Rangatiratanga, Exercising Kaitiakitanga, Exercising rahui.
 - c. NGATI MURIWAI HAPU has undertaken these activities since prior to 1840 and continues to undertake these activities in the application area, albeit in some instances using modern equipment, and in accordance with tikanga.
- 8 NGATI MURIWAI HAPU will deliver more information once funding for research and legal representation is secured.

Grounds on which the customary marine title application is made:

- 9. The grounds on which this order is sought are that:
 - a. NGATI MURIWAI HAPU has held the application area in accordance with tikanga since before 1840.
 - b. NGATI MURIWAI HAPU has exclusively used and occupied the application area prior to 1840 to the present day without substantial interruption.



10. NGATI MURIWAI HAPU will deliver more information once funding for research and legal representation is secured.
