Introduction

1. The applicants, Te Hawe Harvey Ruru, Susan Glenice Paine, Cindy Lou Batt, John Pere Katene, Ngawaina Joy Shorrock, Ronald Keith Riwaka, Venessa Patricia Charmon Turama Ede, William Tahuaroa Reeves, as trustees of Te Ātiawa o Te Waka-a-Māui Trust, will on 3 April 2017 apply under s 100 of the Marine and Coastal Area (Takutai Moana) Act 2011 for an order recognising Te Ātiawa's customary marine titles.

Applicant group including contact details

- 2. The applicants are the trustees of Te Ātiawa o Te Waka-a-Māui Trust, the Post-Settlement Governance Entity of Te Ātiawa o Te Waka-a-Māui people (the "Applicant Group") who whakapapa to Te Tau Ihu (the top of the South Island). The Applicant Group whakapapa into four marae in Te Tau Ihu known as Waikawa (Picton) Te Āwhina (Moteuka), Whakatū (Nelson) and Onetahua (Takaka).

Subject common marine and coastal area

- 4. The application relates to five common marine and coastal areas, as follows (collectively the "Specified Area"):
 - 4.1. the area covering the coastline from Westport in the west, around Farewell Spit, and along to Separation Point and extending from that coastline out to 12 nautical miles, as denoted on the plan attached as **Appendix A** to this application;
 - 4.2. the area covering the coastline from Separation Point southwards to Mapua and extending from that coastline out to 12 nautical miles, as denoted on the plan attached as **Appendix B** to this application;
 - 4.3. the area covering the coastline from Mapua northwards and around Te Hoiere/Pelorus Sound to Port Gore, as well as the coastline around Rangitoto/D'Urville Island, and extending from that coastline out to 12 nautical miles, as denoted on the plan attached as **Appendix C** to this application;
 - 4.4. the area covering all Totaranui/Queen Charlotte Sound and Port Gore extending from Cape Lambert on the northern side of Port Gore north to 12 nautical miles, and from the headland north of Fighting Bay out to the midway point between the north and south islands, including those parts of Te Moana o Raukawakawa (Cook Straight) that lie between the points described above, as denoted on the plan attached as Appendix D to this application; and
 - 4.5. the area covering the coastline from the point north of Fighting Bay along Te Koko-o-Kupe (Cloudy Bay) south to the Clarence River and extending from that coastline out to 12 nautical miles, as denoted on the plan attached as **Appendix E** to this application.

Grounds

- 5. The grounds on which the order is sought are as follows:
 - 5.1. the Applicant Group holds the Specified Area in accordance with tikanga;
 - 5.2. the Applicant Group has in relation to the Specified Area exclusively used and occupied it from 1840 to the present day without substantial interruption; and
 - 5.3. such further grounds as are set out in the following affidavits of filed in support of this application by:
 - 5.3.1. Bentham Atirau Ohia,
 - 5.3.2. Alan Tahuaroa Riwaka,
 - 5.3.3. Andrew Kaponga Clifford Erueti, and
 - 5.3.4. Jane Lu-Cretia Du Feu.
 - 5.3.5. Sharon Gemmell




