#### MINUTE OF CHURCHMAN J

### CIV-2017-485-280 Ngāi Tahu Whanui

- [1] Counsel's memorandum advised that each of the iwi's 18 constituent Papatipu Rūnanga are progressing at variable pace toward preparation for a hearing. Uncertainty as to funding is adversely impacting the ability to make progress.
- [2] Ngāi Tahu is supportive of the hearing for the Ruapuke Island Group proceeding as scheduled.

[3] The Ngāi Tahu application is adjourned to be called again at the 2025 Dunedin CMC and counsel's attendance at the 2024 CMC is excused.

#### CIV-2017-485-296 Ruapuke Island Group

- [4] This matter is scheduled for hearing to commence on 24 March 2025. It is dependant on the availability of Crown funding.
- [5] Once the Crown funding policy clarification (which is anticipated to be announced within the coming weeks) is known, counsel are to file a further memorandum advising whether or not they will be in a position to proceed with the 24 March 2025 hearing.
- [6] Counsel's attendance at the 2024 Dunedin CMC is excused and the Dunedin CMC is vacated.
