[1] These applicants have filed a joint memorandum. It noted that the Surveyor General's final guidelines have not yet been issued and that as a result, final maps and plans have not been able to be finalised. Te Arawhiti have also not confirmed funding

required to instruct the mapping expert to finalise the maps and plans. This has to be resolved before final maps and plans can be prepared.

[2] All applications are adjourned to be called again at the 2025 Napier Case Management Conference (CMC). Should the issues presently preventing finalisation of maps and plans be resolved prior to then, counsel should file a memorandum (or if a joint memorandum is not possible, individual memoranda) and it may be possible to make orders on the papers without waiting until the 2025 CMC.

[3] The 2024 Napier CMC is vacated, and counsel's attendance excused.
