# **MACA Central Bay of Plenty Hearing Overview**

### 1. Hearing Area

This hearing was allocated by Churchman J in December 2022<sup>1</sup> to deal with MACA applications in "the area between the eastern boundary of the Re Reeder priority proceedings and the western boundary of the Re Edwards priority proceedings".

In the map below<sup>2</sup>, hearing area is the central orange section. Re Reeder (Ngā Pōtiki) is the green section on the left and Re Edwards (Whakatōhea) is the green section on the right.

The hearing will take place over ten weeks starting 5 May 2025 in Tauranga. The venue is not yet confirmed.
