
### **MACA Whāingaroa Hearing Overview**

#### 1. Hearing Area

The Whāingaroa Hearing was proposed by the Whāingaroa Moana Collective ahead of the June 2023 MACA Hamilton case management conference with the hearing area defined by the CIV-2017-419-083 Whāingaroa Moana Collective application area. On 20 December 2023, Churchman J allocated a 3-week hearing to determine MACA applications in this area<sup>1</sup>.
