#### JUDGMENT OF THE COURT

# The application for leave to appeal is dismissed with costs of \$2,500 to the respondents.

## REASONS

[1] The exercise by the Court of Appeal<sup>1</sup> of its discretion not to extend time for the appeal was made on a proper basis. In particular, it was entirely orthodox for the Court of Appeal to give some consideration to the merits (or lack of them) when determining the application.

[2] We agree with the view of the Court of Appeal that the proposed appeal was an abuse of process.
