## JUDGMENT OF THE COURT

The application for recall is dismissed.

## **REASONS**

- [1] In a decision dated 28 October 2015, this Court dismissed Mr and Mrs Banks' application for leave to appeal to this Court against a decision of the Court of Appeal.<sup>1</sup>
- [2] On 2 November 2015, Mr and Mrs Banks filed a memorandum which is, in substance, an application for recall of this Court's judgment.
- [3] The substance of Mr and Mrs Banks' recall application mirrors their application for leave to appeal and attempts to re-argue the points dismissed in our leave judgment. This does not provide a proper basis for recall.
