**JUDGMENT OF THE COURT**

**The application for recall is dismissed.**

**REASONS**

[1] The applicant seeks a recall of our judgment of 11 December 2017 dismissing his application for leave to appeal from a decision of Asher J in a minute issued on 6 September 2017.<sup>1</sup>

[2] The application for recall is in substance primarily an attempt to re-argue the application for leave. In addition, the applicant questions the order for costs on the leave application.
